A hard-wired smoke alarm or carbon monoxide alarm is wired to a 120V household electrical circuit and is connected to other detectors throughout your home. These alarms sound simultaneously, on all levels of your home, when a single unit detects smoke or gas.

How to Install Smoke Alarms - The Home Depot

For the best protection, heat alarms should always be installed as part of a complete fire protection system that includes smoke alarms. Make sure you: Install smoke alarms in circulation areas at a distance no greater than 7.5 m from the farthest wall, no greater than 7.5 m from a door to any room in which a fire might start and no greater than 7.5 m from the next smoke alarm.
